

Institute of Occupational Safety and Health (IOSH) "Working Safely"

This one training course will provide a foundation of knowledge and greater awareness in relation to Health & Safety, managing and reducing risk.

Working safely meets the government's guidelines for introductory health and safety training and is a 100 per cent match to the Health and Safety Executive's 'passport' syllabus.

The training day will bridge the gap between management and workforce, encouraging delegates to play a part in processes that are commonly seen as manager / supervisor responsibility. Candidates will be able to explore two key areas – health and safety *and* environmental basics.
